

- For this newsletter, our financial report is simple:

Chambley Air Base The European Aeronautics Park

Air hase of Chambley-Bussieres (Orpartment of Meurthe-et-Moselle) a the heart of the Regional Nature Park of Lorraine Philippe Buron de Rozier and Aline Dufour presented a superb briefing on future Chambley Air Base development plans

These exciting plans have been in the making since the mid-1980s when the vision began. They envision a large European Aeronautics Park where all sorts of



other activities.

international aerial activities will be conducted including balloon festivals (as happens every two years now), small aircraft are built and maintained, airshows of various descriptions occur, and people who love flght will live with their aircraft sheltered outside their homes, among



This effort involves their organization partnering with regional and local government agencies to build

this future aeronautical capability that will add jobs and opportunities to the region.









Project developers will begin the effort by destroying older buildings such as barracks that are too costly to refurbish. They will retain and upgrade the three hangars, the tower'base ops building, and the chapel (to be used as a museum of the history of aeronautical activities in the region and Chambley's

USAF contributions to NATO).

Philippe invited the Reunion Alumni to join them 29 July – 2 August 2009 for the 11th International
